

Art. 27 - Exam evaluation

1. The didactic regulations of the study courses establish the type of verification tests that determine the overcoming of the exam and the acquisition of the ECTSs, at the same time they establish if there are any prerequisites. The tests may consist of examinations (oral and/or written), or passing other verification tests (oral and/or written tests, labs, oral presentations, student's projects, interviews, etc.). For courses organized in several teaching modules, the verification test must verify the knowledge gained in all the modules.
2. The evaluation of the exams is expressed in thirtieths, which means in a scale from 1 up to 30 (the best score), with the possibility of distinction/honor "cum laude". The exam is passed with a minimum grade of 18 out of 30. Other verification tests may have an evaluation that do not uses numerical grades.
3. Before starting the exam, the student must be identified by the Commission/Professor via an ID card.
4. All tests of examination and verification are public.
5. The student has the right to view his / her exam papers after the correction, no later than the next exam session. After this date the written exam papers will no longer be available.
6. Exams registered with negative marks lead to exclusion from the next upcoming exam within the same session, but some study courses may have different regulations about this specific case.
7. The student can withdraw from the exam at any moment before the end of the exam. During oral exams the student can withdraw until the commission is about to record the eventual positive mark of the test. The results of the written exams are published on the University website, in the page of the results of the exams; at the same time the date when the mark will be officially recorded is also published on the esse3 website. The student who wants to withdraw from the exam must inform the Commission/Professor before the vote is officially recorded. In any case, the presence of the student is not mandatory for the official record of the vote. The student can no longer withdraw once the result of the examination has been officially recorded.
8. Without prejudice to the possible cases permitted by the didactic Regulations, it is not allowed to repeat an exam already successfully passed, also if it has been passed during an international mobility program.
9. Exams and other tests are void if the corresponding lecture/educational activity is not included in the study plan, if the student has not yet acquired the attendance (it can be easily checked online on the esse3 platform), in case of non-compliance with the prerequisites, if the student is not enrolled for that academic year.
